In addition to her duties as Senior Director of Practice Activities, Obstetrics, and Immunization at ACOG, Ms. Hawks serves as deputy to the Vice President in his absence. Ms. Hawks directs the College's Immunization department and provides leadership and vision for the activities. She supervises the College's Immunization staff and monitors the College's several immunization grants.
