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Dr. Snow is a general internist with special interests in adult immunization, evidence-based guideline development, clinical policy, medical education, performance measurement, and practice-based quality improvement. She has served on many national committees and policy bodies such as the CDC ACIP Evidence-based Recommendations Work Group, the Institute of Medicine (IOM) Roundtable on Evidence-based Guidelines, the provider workgroup (former chair) of the CDC/AMA Influenza Summit, liaison to the USPSTF of the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality, and the National Committee for Quality Assurance, among many others.

Dr. Snow was at the American College of Physicians for 11 years where she was the Director of Clinical Programs and Quality of Care. Her responsibilities included leading the ACP's Clinical Practice Guidelines program and Performance Measurement activities. She has authored and had published over 80 articles including national practice guidelines and clinical policies. She is the editor of two medical texts, *Clinical Practice* and *Screening for Diseases*, and has authored many book chapters including chapters in electronic medical education tools such as the *ACP Patient Centered Medical Home Builder* and *Virtual Diagnosis*.
