Barbie Robinson has over 18 years of experience in the fields of health policy, operations, and research. She began her Federal career as a Policy Analyst with the Department of Health and Human Services Office of Inspector General, Office of Evaluations and Inspections, where she conducted research and policies studies on a variety of health policy topics, including Medicare, Medicaid, and the Children's Health Insurance Program.

In 2002, Ms. Robinson joined the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) in the Division of Medicaid and Children's Health Operations. She held several positions in the Division of Medicaid & Children's Health Operations until 2008 when she became the Program Branch Manager in the Division. In 2010, she became the Technical Director in the Division of Medicare & Fee-for-Service Operations, where she supported the Associate Regional Administrator in developing national policy and guidelines to for all program integrity-related responsibilities.

Later in 2010, Ms. Robinson became the Associate Regional Administrator (ARA) for the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services' San Francisco Division of Financial Management and Fee for Service Operations (DFMFFSO). In 2014, she became the ARA for this same division in the CMS Atlanta Regional Office. This division is one of ten regional divisions within the Consortium for Financial Management & Fee for Service Operations. In this position she is responsible for directing staff to oversee the performance of Medicare fee-for-service contractors responsible for administering the Medicare fee-for-service program in Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina and Tennessee. In addition, she plans and directs staff to conduct outreach and education, provide customer service to respond to inquiries from provider associations, beneficiary groups, congressional offices and other stakeholders. She directs staff to negotiate and settle Federal debt associated with coordination of benefits for the Medicare Secondary Payer program, including Worker's Compensation Medicare Set Aside arrangements. In addition, she serves as the Lead Functional Associate Regional Administrator for Chief Financial Officer. In this capacity, she is responsible for directing division managers in carrying out all Chief Financial Officer-related work assignments.

Ms. Robinson has been a licensed attorney in the state of California for 12 years and holds a Master's of Public Policy from Georgetown University and a Bachelor's of Arts from Middlebury College.
