L.J Tan joined the Immunization Action Coalition on January 1, 2013. Prior to that, Dr. Tan was the Director of Medicine and Public Health at the American Medical Association (AMA) for 15 years. Dr. Tan also serves as Co-Chair of the National Adult and Influenza Immunization Summit, together with CDC and NVPO.

Dr. Tan recently served on the National Quality Forum's Adult Immunizations Expert Committee, and currently serves on the Pharmacy Quality Alliance's Adult Immunization Working Group, on the European Society of Clinical Microbiology and Infectious Diseases Vaccine Study Group (EVASG), and as an editor for the Journal for Disaster Medicine and Public Health Preparedness, BMC Infectious Diseases, and Medscape Infectious Diseases.

He just completed his term as an elected member of the federal National Vaccine Advisory Committee (NVAC). He still serves on the NVAC's HPV and Vaccine Confidence working groups. Previously, L.J chaired the Immunization Infrastructure WG and also served on the vaccine safety WG.

Dr. Tan served as a liaison member of the federal Advisory Committee for Immunization Practices (ACIP) for 12 years, and he still serves on the Adult Immunization working group. Previously, he also served on the influenza, zoster, and evidence-based working groups.
