The National Adult and Influenza Immunization Summit (NAIIS) is asking the public to help educate adults about the importance of adult vaccines. In addition to a **monetary prize** of \$750 and \$350 for first and second-place videos respectively, the top three videos will receive **recognition** from the NAIIS, National Foundation for Infectious Diseases, Immunization Action Coalition, and other partners.
