Framework to support implementation

Requirements for Practice Change

1. Valid, legitimate, accepted evidence
2. Clinician/staff knowledge, skill
3. Supportive professional norms (training of trainees?)
4. External expectations, monitoring, pressure/incentives
5. Patient acceptance
6. Evidence of quality gaps (e.g. vaccination rates)
7. Etiology of practices, quality gaps
8. Feasible methods/systems (payment/financing)

Main issues/concerns prioritized by Provider and Access Working Groups – What are steps NAIIS or NAIIS members can to do make progress?

Lead Issues – pre-summit discussions

1. What is cost of providing vaccination services and do payments cover the costs?
2. Coding requirements confusing and differ by payer – what can NAIIS do to help providers knowledge and accuracy of coding? Knowledge of ways providers can bill Medicare D?
3. What can NAIIS do to help providers with billing questions?
4. Adult patients have many providers and gaps in communication among providers about vaccines given. How can NAIIS help improve communications? Use of IIS?
5. What are the implications of new payment models, including MACRA, on patient access to vaccination services? How can providers get needed information about costs and payments for vaccines and vaccination?
6. What can be done to improve routine assessment of vaccination status?
