Dr. Chewning is co-director of the Pharmacy Practice Enhancement and Action Research Link (PEARL Rx), a pharmacy-based research network with 140 member Wisconsin pharmacists. She has been an active researcher serving as principal investigator on several federal grants, reviewer on numerous NIH and AHRQ study sections and research journals, and was president of the American Association of Colleges of Pharmacy SAS Division. Her research focuses on patient and provider partnerships to foster improved patient outcomes as well as system issues for advancement of pharmacist roles including immunizations. She has partnered with community leaders in reservations and inner city locations to offer and evaluate multi-site public health and patient interventions.

Dr. Chewning completed her undergraduate work at the University of Chicago, and she received her PhD in Educational Psychology from the University of Wisconsin-Madison.
