Adult Vaccine Recommendation Update, Flu Vaccine Coverage Estimates - Carolyn Bridges, MD, Associate Director for Adult Immunizations, Immunization Services Division, National Center for Immunization and Respiratory Diseases, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention

Dr. Bridges reviewed changes to the 2017 adult immunization schedule, which will be posted in the Annals of Internal Medicine on February 7, 2017. See presentation slides for details.

CDC will be undergoing an evaluation project in 2017 to conduct in-depth interviews with health care providers who use the schedule to describe how the schedule is used, identify health care provider perspectives on readability and usability, and conduct a needs assessment. Eventually, job aides and tools will be developed based on the interview findings.

Adult Immunization Resource Guide, Association of Immunization Managers (AIM) Update - Katelyn Wells, PhD, Research and Development Director, AIM
