Dr. Richard H. Beigi is an Associate Professor of Reproductive Sciences in the Department of OB/GYN/RS at Magee-Womens Hospital of the University of Pittsburgh Medical Center. He is a fellowship-trained specialist in Reproductive Infectious Diseases and has an active clinical practice providing consultation in Infectious Diseases in Obstetrics and Gynecology. He has published extensively and is an active and funded investigator (CDC, NIH, BARDA, and pharmaceutical funding sources) in the area of infectious diseases prevention and management in Obstetrics. His area of focus involves the design and testing of numerous prophylactic and therapeutic pharmaceutical products in pregnant and lactating women, a traditionally understudied population.

Dr. Beigi serves in an advisory role to numerous federal agencies and/or professional societies regarding infectious diseases in pregnancy and immunization including NIH, FDA, CDC, NVAC, ACOG, and NFID.
