Dr. Hall joined Sustainable Healthy Communities (SHC) in November, 2016. Launched by Dr. Gary Puckrein and the National Minority Quality Forum, SHC is a pioneering health care information company that measures population health in every community and patient population. SHC promotes cost-effective health outcomes and health equity through big data analytics coupled with impactful visualization and education. The core SHC data products, customizable and actionable health indices and geomaps, reflect exclusively licensed data from the NMQF. Visually mapping disease prevalence, patient and provider characteristics, treatment access, hospital use, costs, and more, is a powerful guide to efficient planning, resource distribution, quality improvement, and advocacy. The data platform inform all of SHC services, including quality improvement-education to clinicians, community leaders, and patients; clinical trial recruitment services; research; and advisory meeting services.

Prior to joining SHC, Dr. Hall founded and lead the Center for Quality and Office of Grants at the American College of Physicians (ACP), creating a network of more than 2,000 primary care physicians in 19 states engaged in quality improvement (QI) activities along with the largest federally qualified registry for Medicare reporting. Previously, Dr. Hall led Strategic Educational Initiatives at the American College of Cardiology (ACC) and served as the deputy director of the National Alliance for the Mentally Ill (NAMI), leading advocacy, communications, and research activities. Dr. Hall began her post-graduate career as a senior scientific analyst at the U.S. Congress' Office of Technology Assessment, leading the development of reports on advances in neurosciences relevant to mental illness and the application of the Americans with Disabilities Act employment provisions to mental illness.

Dr. Hall graduated summa cum laude from St. Francis University in Pennsylvania in 1983 and received her Ph.D. in neuroscience from the Naval Medical School, U.S.U.H.S. in 1988. Her post-doctoral work was conducted at the National Institutes of Health and Bloomberg School of Public Health at JHU.

Dr. Hall is the proud mother of Henry and Isabella Pazaryna, and wife of the Rev. Dr. John Randolph Price, with whom she resides in Anne Arundel County, Maryland.
