Dr. Carolyn Bridges is a board-certified internal medicine physician. She is currently a medical writer-editor for Berry Technology, Inc., after having retired from CDC in August 2017 after 7 years as the Associate Director of Adult Immunizations in the Immunization Services Division. She was a founding co-lead of the National Adult and Influenza Immunization Summit. She also led the Summit development of the Practice Standards for Adult Immunization, which were later adopted by NVAC.

Dr. Bridges was in clinical practice before joining the CDC as an Epidemic Intelligence Service Officer in 1996. She held a number of different positions at CDC working on influenza and other vaccine preventable diseases and was the Associate Director of Adult Immunizations from 2011-2017, until her retirement from CDC.

Her career has included research and policy on influenza prevention and control, vaccine effectiveness, transmission, and improving coverage for recommended adult vaccines. She continues to focus on increasing the evidence base for adult vaccinations and vaccine implementation, as well as adult vaccination policy and education. She is a co-lead of the Adult Immunizations Working Group of the Idaho Immunization Coalition.

Dr. Bridges has authored or co-authored over 100 articles and book chapters.
