At CDC Dr. Ferdinands' area of expertise is influenza vaccine effectiveness, and she leads CDC's multi-site study of the effectiveness of influenza vaccine in preventing hospitalization among adults. Other research interests and areas of subject matter expertise include epidemiologic methods research for improving observational studies of vaccine effectiveness and disease modeling.

Prior to joining the Influenza Division, Dr. Ferdinands was a Commander in the US Public Health Service at CDC, where she focused on the investigation of asthma and other respiratory health conditions. She holds a doctoral degree in health policy from Harvard University.
