Dr. Green began her career in Austin, TX working as a semiconductor engineer for Toppan Photomasks, Incorporated. During her years of employment with Toppan, she held several positions ranging from manufacturing of phase shift masks to product integration engineer. She joined Ochsner in 2014 as an inpatient staff pharmacist at the Slidell, LA hospital campus and later joined Ochsner Main Campus located in New Orleans for her current role.

As Population Management Pharmacist, she is responsible for assisting with efforts to improve their quality measure outcomes, increase vaccination rates in the pediatric and adult population, increasing comprehensive medication reviews performed by pharmacists, and improving patients' medication adherence for the treatment of chronic health conditions and process improvement projects.
