Dr. Ward has been an Associate Professor of Medicine and Microbiology since 1991. He is chief of the Division of Infectious Diseases and associate Director of the McGill Centre for Tropical Diseases. He is also Director of the (Health Canada) National Reference Centre for Parasitology.

Dr. Ward has served or continues to serve on a number of national and international advisory committees in the areas of vaccine use, vaccine safety and international health. He has active research interests in vaccine development, parasitological and international health supported by Canadian and international funding agencies as well as private foundations and industry. He served as a Member of Infectious Disease Advisory Board of Methygene Inc.

As a student at McGill University, Dr. Ward received numerous scholarships and awards including a Rhodes Scholarship (Québec - Corpus Christi 1977-1979). He completed an internship at the Queen Elizabeth Hospital in 1981 and residency training in internal medicine and infectious diseases at Johns Hopkins University from 1985 to 1991. Dr. Ward completed his medical training at McGill University in 1980.
