Vaccines National Strategic Plan, 2021-2025

- Released in January 2021 and can be found:

- Comprehensive strategic framework to promote vaccines and vaccinations with five goals, objectives, and strategies in the following areas:
 - research and development,
 - vaccine safety and monitoring,
 - public knowledge and confidence,
 - access and use across the lifespan, and
 - global cooperation.
- Developed in partnership with:
 - External nongovernmental stakeholders.
 - Federal Interagency Vaccine Work Group (IVWG), which serves as the Steering Committee.

Vaccines Federal Implementation Plan

- Accompanies and aligns with the Vaccines National Strategic Plan and its goals, objectives, and strategies.
- Outlines the roles of Federal departments and agencies and their specific contributions to achieve the National Strategic Plan.
 - Details current activities from members agency that contributes to the Strategic Plan.
 - Includes recommended activities that were collected in last year's public comment period.
- Partnering and collaborating with the IVWG.
 - Updated member roster with 14 Departments and agencies and 25 individual members.
 - New member: HHS Office of Global Affairs
 - Finalized the IVWG charge of roles and responsibilities.
 - Convened meeting with IVWG on September 21.
 - Developed and disseminated customized data collection tool to each IVWG member agency.
