Dr. Carolyn Bridges is a board-certified internal medicine physician who has worked on influenza and adult immunization issues for 30 years. She completed medical school at University of Washington, and internal medicine residency at University of Colorado. After working as a primary care physician following residency, she joined the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention as an Epidemic Intelligence Service Officer and later became the Associate Director for Science in the Influenza Division and then Associate Director of Adult Immunizations. Her work at CDC focused primarily on influenza, and adult immunization policy and implementation.

Since retiring from CDC in 2017, she has consulted with Immunize.org as the Director of Adult Immunizations.

Dr. Bridges has over 160 publications including peer-reviewed manuscripts, textbook chapters, CDC adult immunization schedules and influenza ACIP recommendations. She also has provided clinical care in FQHCs in Atlanta and now Boise for over 20 years.
