She is currently the Acting Chief of CORVD's Surveillance and Prevention Branch where she oversees efforts to monitor trends in medically attended illness, disease burden, and vaccine effectiveness for COVID-19, RSV, and other respiratory viruses to inform prevention and treatment strategies.
