Annie Fedorowicz is the Adolescent and Adult Immunization Coordinator in the Vaccine Preventable Disease Section of the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) and has been working in her adult immunization role since November of 2012. Annie works primarily on enhancing adolescent and adult immunization programs by addressing immunization coverage gaps through best practice and quality improvement educational outreach efforts. During the pandemic, Annie worked on the COVID-19 vaccine response, including the coordination of the vaccine rollout in long-term care settings as well as leading pharmacy vaccinator partner engagement. Annie continues to serve on the executive committee of the National Adult Immunization Coordinators' Partnership (NAICP), which was relaunched in January of 2023.

Annie graduated from St. Olaf College with her BA in Chemistry and Women Studies in 2008, and received her MPH in Maternal and Child Health with an Epidemiology emphasis from the University of Minnesota in 2012.
