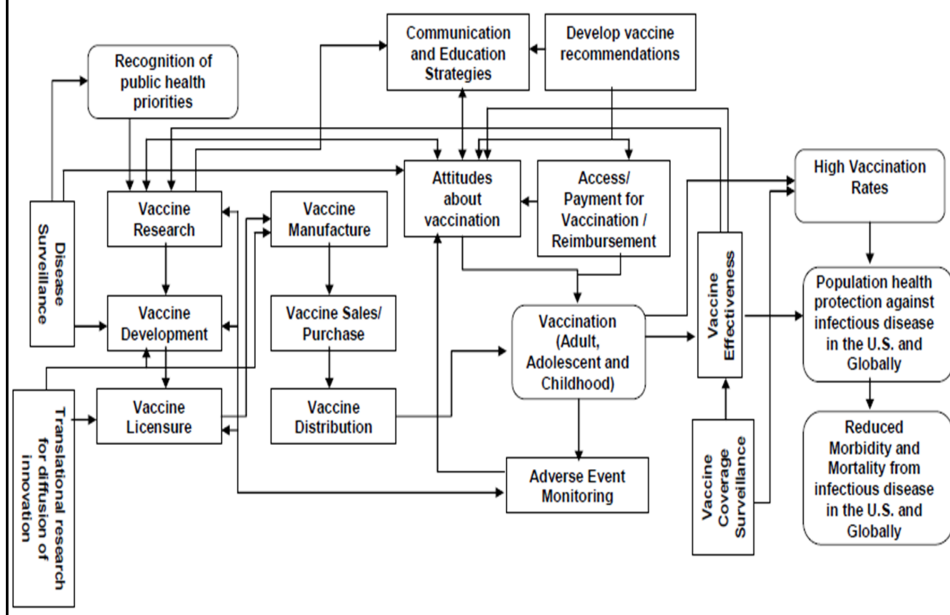
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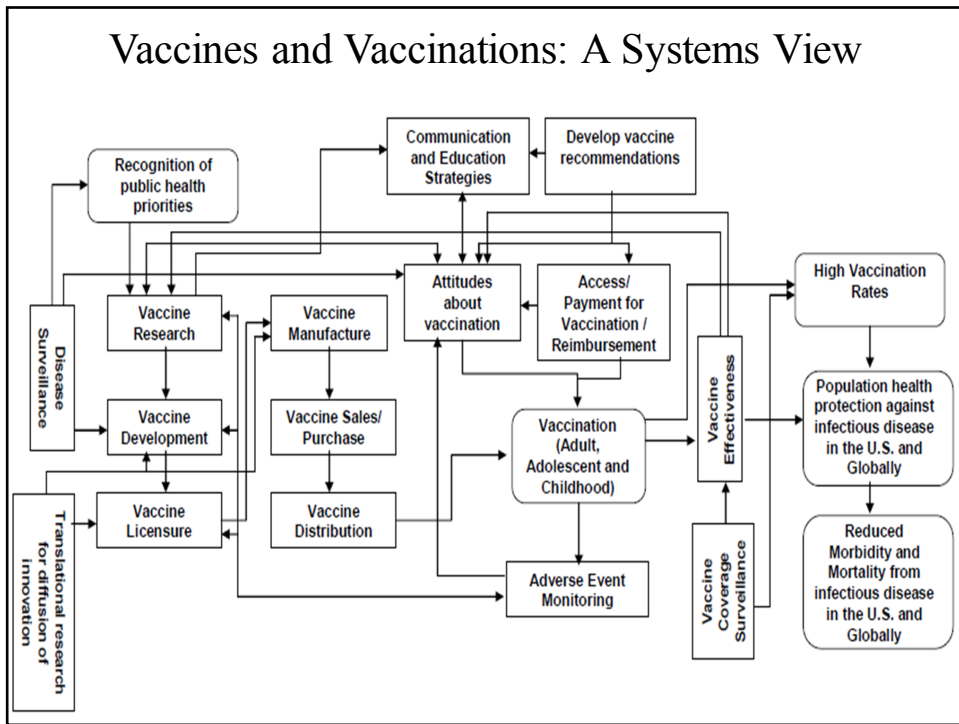
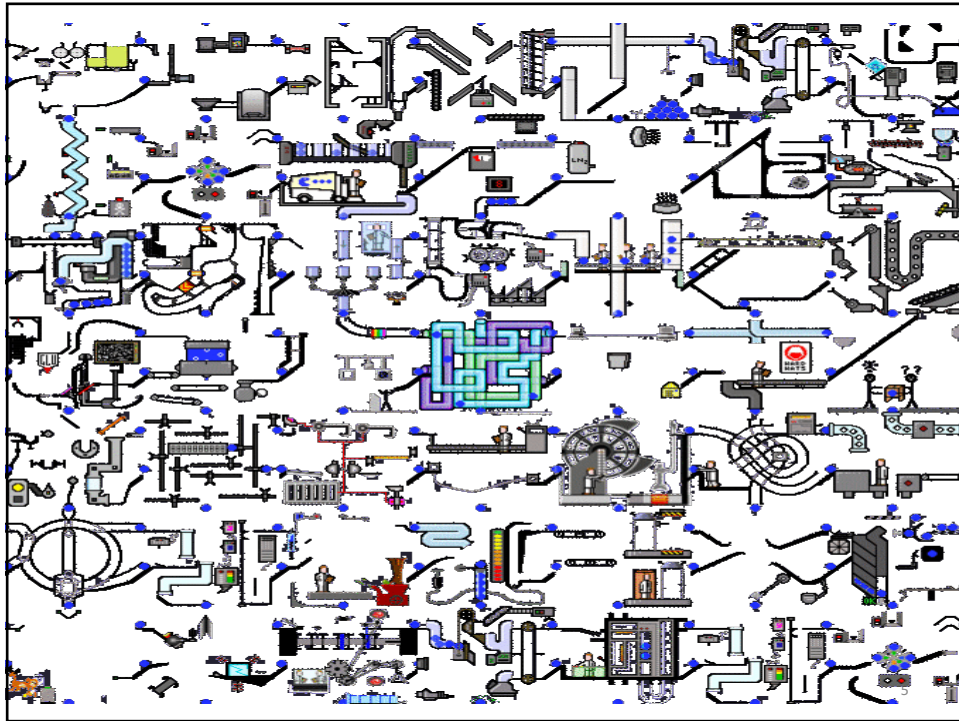

Foster innovation in adult vaccine development and vaccination related

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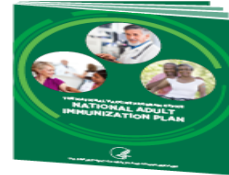
