February - April

- WHO announces the official name for the disease – 2019 Novel Coronavirus or “COVID-19”
- Washington Department of Public Health report the first death in a male in his 50s
- WHO declares COVID-19 a pandemic
- Travel bans
- Schools closed
- Quarantine and social distancing
- Mask guidelines

May - August

- Number of confirmed COVID-19 cases surpasses 2 million
- US Reports record number of infections in a single day: 75,600
- Deaths exceed more than 1,000 per day

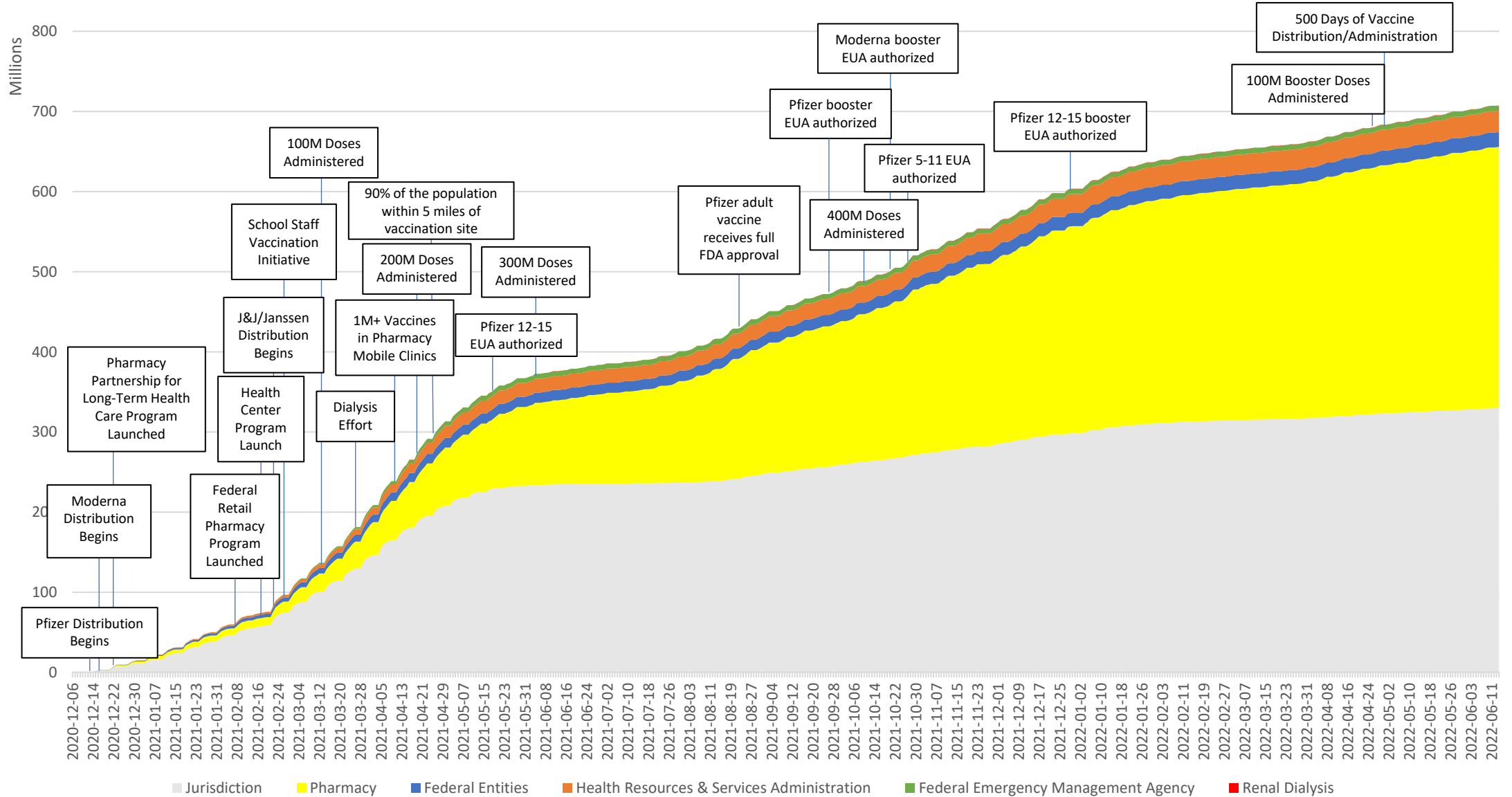

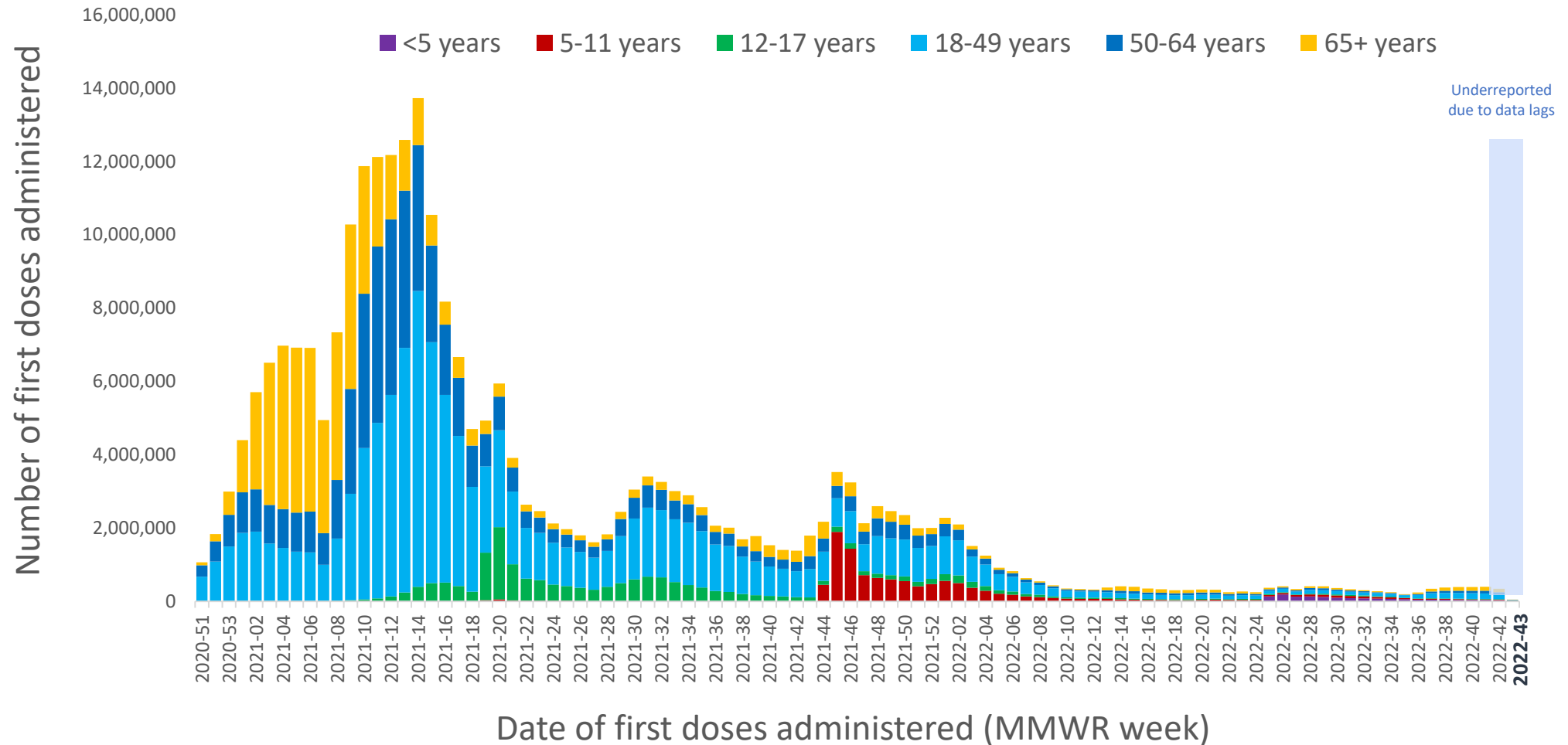

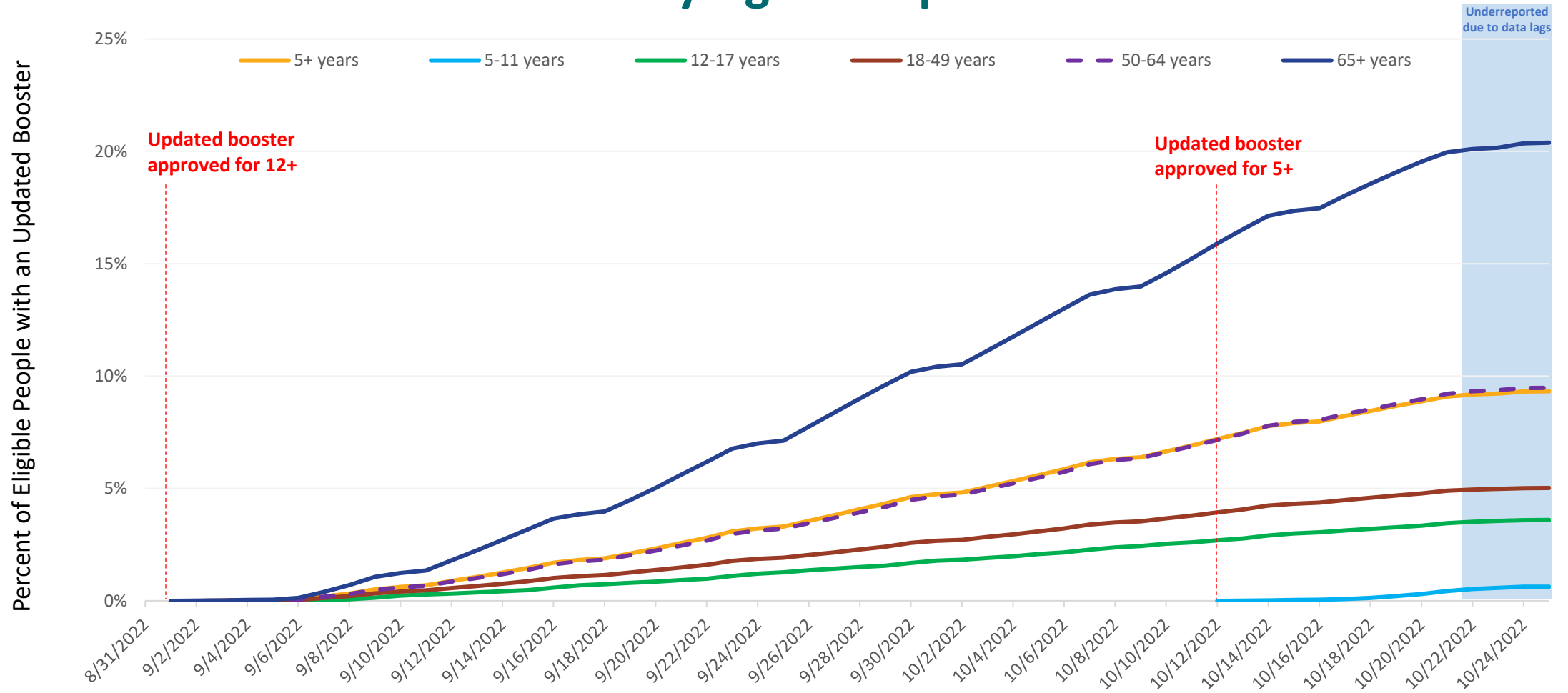
Weekly Number of COVID-19 Vaccine First Doses Administered by Age Group, Starting December 14, 2020

Notes: Updated (bivalent) booster counts include the number of people administered a vaccine dose with a CVX code 229 (Moderna ages 6+) or 300 (Pfizer ages 12+) on or after September 1, 2022 or a CVX code 301 (Pfizer ages 5-11) on or after October 12, 2022. Approximately 900 children ages 6 to 17 years received the updated Moderna booster dose between September 1, and October 11, 2022. Number of people eligible for an updated booster includes people who received a primary series completion \geq 2 months ago. Excludes data submitted via aggregate (TX all ages and ID pediatrics below 18 years of age) because booster doses cannot be linked to primary series with the aggregate data.
