**Overview of SAVRR Implementation Guidance on Fall Respiratory Season Vaccination**

**Recommendations- Bob Hopkins**

- SAVRR Council implementation guidance states that for the fall 2026 viral respiratory season, providers should follow the current (existing) vaccination recommendations on influenza, COVID-19, and RSV from AAP, AAFP, ACOG, and IDSA, and ACIP recommendations up to June 2025, until updated recommendations from AAP, AAFP, ACOG, and IDSA are released this fall.
